Cancellation Policy: All reservations are subject to cancellation policies. Please refer to your confirmation for your cancellation policy or contact our reservations office. There is no refund on unused portions of a package. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance at www.clippervacations.com.

U.S. Customs: U.S. regulations on restricted items are available.

Canada Customs: Prohibited and Restricted Weapons: All automatic weapons, handguns, mace and pepper spray. Items mentioned are not all inclusive. Please contact Canada Customs for further information, and for information on importation of regulated firearms.

Travel Insurance: Travel insurance available at www.clippervacations.com. Click on the "Access America" button.

Immigration: Identification is necessary for Customs and Border Protection. Due to heightened security at the United States/Canadian border crossing, all travelers are encouraged to travel with a passport if available. If you are a United States or Canadian born citizen you will need to present government issued Photo ID, such

as a driver license as proof of identity, along with proof of citizenship, such as a birth certificate or naturalization certificate.

U.S. citizens who are Washington State residents are eligible to purchase an Enhanced Driver License (EDL) for \$15.00 more than a standard license. The EDL will meet the requirements for proof of citizenship to reenter the U.S. from Canada and Mexico by land or sea. If you are not a United States or Canadian born citizen you will be required to have a passport and possibly a Visa.

Children age 18 and under will be able to enter with proof of citizenship. If both parents are not traveling they must have written authorization from the other parent or proof of custody. See website for important details.

Drinking and Driving: Canadian law defines Driving While Intoxicated or Driving Under the influence as a felony, which would prevent entry into Canada.

Clipper's Responsibility: Transportation of passengers and baggage is provided by Clipper Navigation, Inc. and is governed by the "Terms and Conditions" available at Clipper terminals.

Whitefish

Day 1 • Seattle - Whitefish
