San Juan Islands via Victoria Clipper

A Fully Narrated Scenic Cruise from Seattle

You'll board the Victoria Clipper III in the morning at downtown Seattle's Pier 69 and cruise out of Elliott Bay going north through Puget Sound. Following the east coast of Whidbey Island, view the Cascade Mountains while watching an assortment of vessels including small sailboats and freighters from around the world.

Passing through Saratoga Passage, you will have the unique experience of traversing scenic Deception Pass. Continuing through Rosario Strait and entering the San Juan Archipelago, you'll wind through channels and islands, possibly spotting whales, porpoise, eagles and other wildlife.

These islands are home to orca whales, blacktail deer and over 100 pairs of bald eagles. Your narrator will identify special points of interest throughout the trip.

Friday Harbor

In a few hours, you'll arrive at picturesque Friday Harbor on San Juan Island. Enjoy about 5 hours ashore to lunch on local seafood and soak up local color, as well as shop, browse the town's galleries, tarry in a pub, stop by the fascinating Whale Museum or enjoy Clipper's own 2.5 hour Whale & Sealife Search, allowing about 2.5 hours ashore, following the excursion.

Finally, you'll return to Seattle on a more direct route, cruising past Port Townsend and enjoying more of Washington's 1,000 miles of diverse scenic coastline.

Options include an overnight on San Juan Island, or a connecting trip to Victoria or Vancouver, BC. See inside for details on several overnight package options.

The San Juan Islands are world-renowned for both the resident pods of orca whales, as well as the migratory pods that feed in the area. The Islands are also teeming with other wildlife and sealife that call the San Juans home.

Join us aboard the triple decked 200 passenger Victoria Clipper III to enjoy outdoor viewing, or stay in and enjoy through large viewing windows. For your comfort and enjoyment, food and beverages, restrooms, binocular rental and a Trained Naturalist are available all on board.

Unique to Clipper, our Trained Naturalist will not only help spot and identify the orca whales, but will educate you about these highly intelligent and social 8-ton animals, their habits and introduce you to other marine and wild life.

The Clipper Whale & Sealife Search begins in Friday Harbor. Once underway, our Naturalist begins a narration on the natural history and wildlife of the San Juan Islands. Soaring eagles, seals sunning themselves, playful Dall's Porpoise and sea lions are just some of the wildlife which are normally spotted.

Keeping in close contact with other vessels, the location of any whales in the area can be determined and the Victoria Clipper III's speed allows us to reach areas with the best viewing.

After 2.5 spectacular hours, the boat docks back in Friday Harbor, so you may enjoy the rest of your time on San Juan Island.

Finish up your day in town, before returning to Seattle, or spend the night and continue your adventure the following day!

San Juan Islands

Tours from Seattle to San Juan Island

Once a mountain range, now an archipelago, the 100-million-year-old San Juan Islands feature some of the most spectacular scenery in the Northwest. Depending on the tides, the San Juans number anywhere from 428 to 743 islands. Only 172 islands have received names, including the four largest: orcas, San Juan, Shaw and Lopez. World-renowned for both the resident pods of orca whales and migratory pods that feed in the area, the San Juan Islands also teem with other wildlife and sealife. Bald eagles, the playful Dall's porpoise, blacktail deer, seals and otters are just some of the creatures you might spot during your trip. Add to these, wonderful tidepools full of starfish and sea anemones, wind-swept madrona trees clutching hillsides, and terrific inns and resorts, and it's easy to see why the islands are such a popular retreat for residents of the Northwest.

San Juan Islands Day Trip • 1 DAY

Depart from downtown Seattle's Pier 69 aboard the 200-passenger Victoria Clipper III. You will head north on a scenic cruise through Deception Pass enroute to quaint Friday Harbor on San Juan Island and the start of your 2.5 hour Whale and Sealife excursion. An onboard Naturalist will help spot and identify the orca whales and other sea and wild life while you view from one of 3 decks. After arriving back into the Port of Friday Harbor, you will have just over 2 hours to shop, browse or grab a bite to eat in this seaside town of about 1,800 residents. Return to Seattle that evening.
